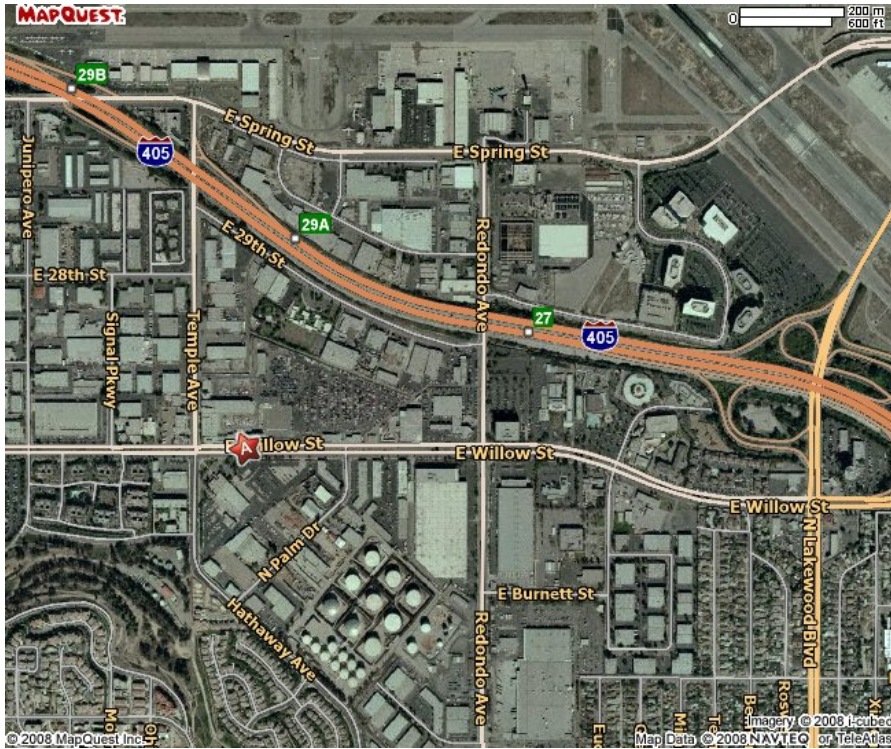

Directions:

- 405 North exit North Lakewood , Right turn on Willow, The Environmental Services Bureau building will appear on the right in approximately 1 mile

Or

- 405 South exit North Lakewood , Right turn on Willow, The Environmental Services Bureau building will appear on the right in approximately 1 mile
- North 405 and South 405 Lakewood exits are located adjacent to one another.

Parking:

- Guests must enter on Willow St.
- There are approximately 19 parking spaces adjacent to the entrance on Willow.
- There is overflow parking off of Temple Ave (see attached map). Do not park past the gates because partners will end up mixed with the City of Long Beach Fleet Parking. (See above map)
