Inspection Program Status

- Los Angeles County Environmental Health:
 - 29 markets on a semiannual basis
- Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA):
 - 12 markets on a monthly basis
- Long Beach Environmental Health:
 - 15 markets three times a year
- California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG):
 - Commercial (dockside and marine) inspections
 - Angler (pier) inspections



December Enforcement Call

- Date: December 17, 2008
- Purpose:
 - Update inspection forms and instructions
 - Increase coordination with CDFG & Health Inspectors





Collaboration Opportunities for CDFG and Inspectors

- Scenario 1:
 - CDFG wardens accompany health inspectors on inspections





Collaboration Opportunities for CDFG and Inspectors

- Scenario 2:
 - Health inspectors independently investigate market
 - Inspector provides warden with offending supplier information





Collaboration Opportunities for CDFG and Inspectors

- Scenario 3:
 - Health inspectors independently investigate market & takes photographic evidence of contraband
 - Inspector provides evidence to CDFG to proceed legally





CDFG Work Plan Meeting

- Date: February 5, 2009
- Purpose: Finalize the work activities and timeline in the PV Shelf EPA/CDFG work plan





Enforcement Program

- In-Water Commercial Fishing
 - Conduct inspection in ocean within the existing commercial catch ban area





Enforcement Program

- Commercial Fish Business
 - In coordination with health departments, conduct enforcement efforts targeting wholesale and retail fish business selling white croakers to the public





Enforcement Program

- In-Water Recreational Fishing
 - Conduct inspection in ocean near and within the existing commercial catch ban area





Enforcement Program

- Land-based Recreational Fishing
 - Conduct inspection of white croaker catch limit along shoreline of PV Peninsula





Monitoring Program

- Commercial Fishing
 - Dockside: Assist EPA in dockside monitoring of white croakers





Monitoring Program

- Recreational Fishing
 - Assist in collecting white croaker at the PV Peninsula shoreline areas during bag limit inspection
