

# PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH: COMPLY WITH WHITE CROAKER COMMERCIAL CATCH BAN

Under California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG) regulations, it is illegal to catch white croaker in waters from 0 to 3 nautical miles from shore extending oceanward between a line 312 degrees magnetic from Point Vicente in Los Angeles County, and a line extending 166 degrees magnetic from Point Fermin in Los Angeles County . \*

White croaker, also known as kingfish or tomcod, caught near the Palos Verdes shelf contains high levels of DDTs and PCBs . The consumption of white croaker caught in this location can lead to serious health risks.
