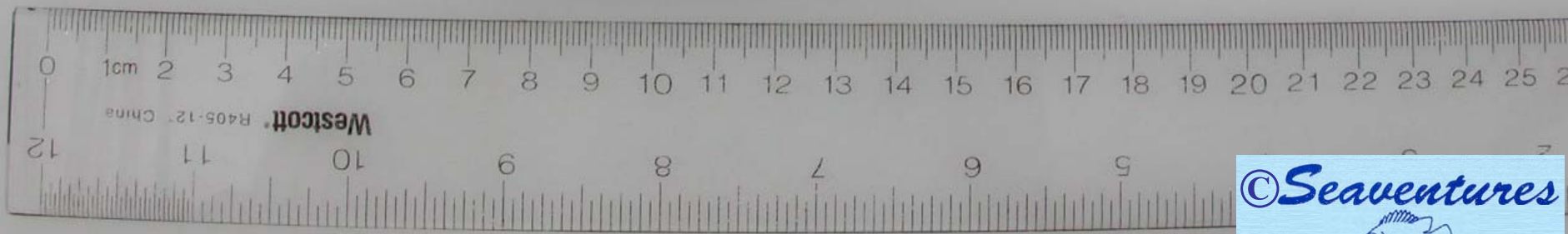

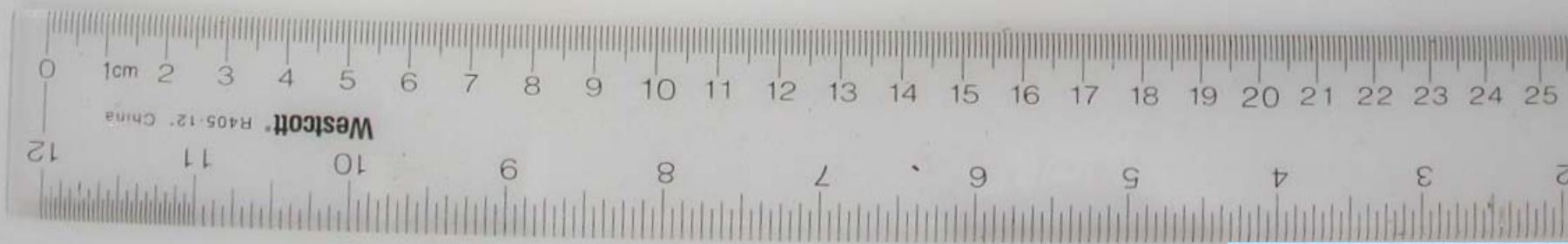

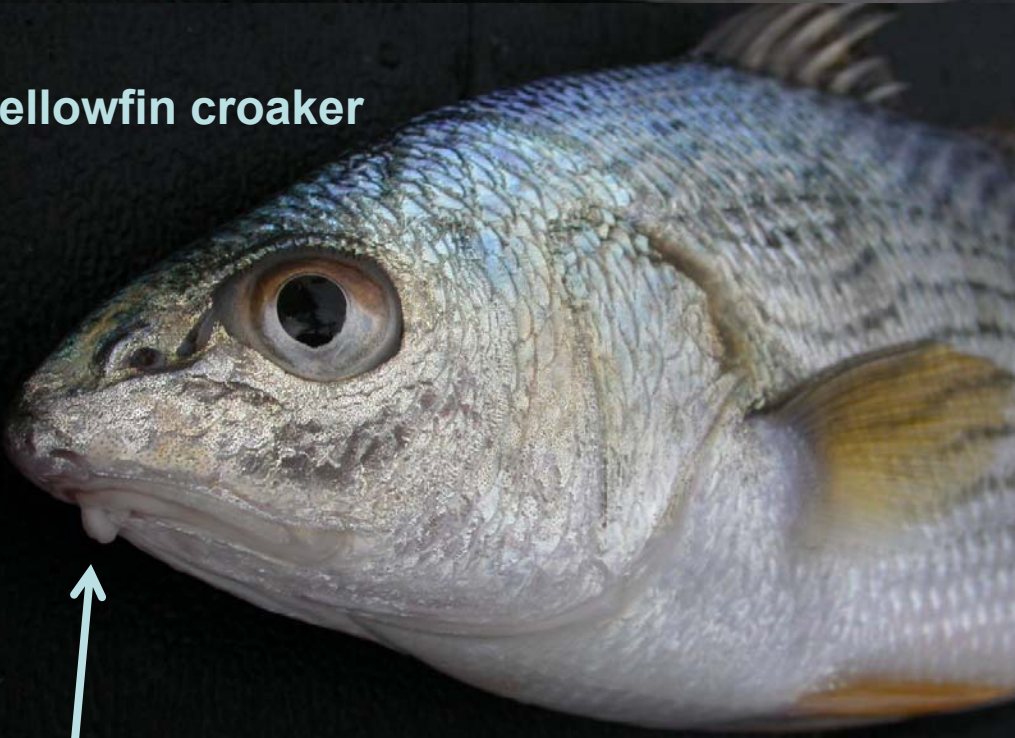


White croaker

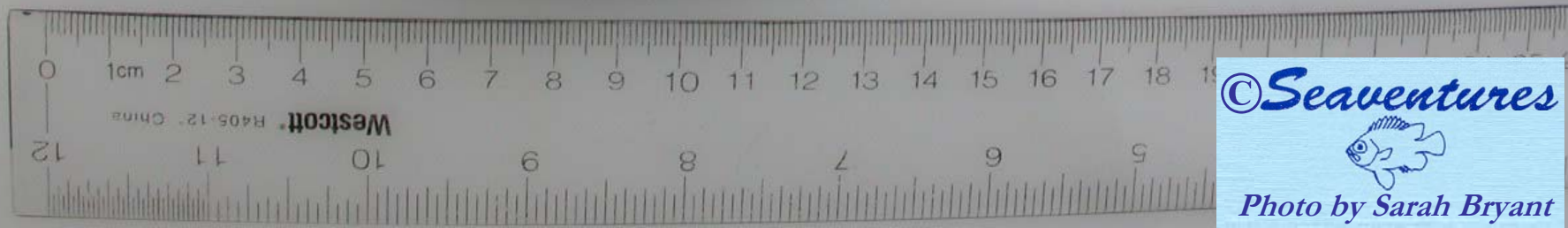

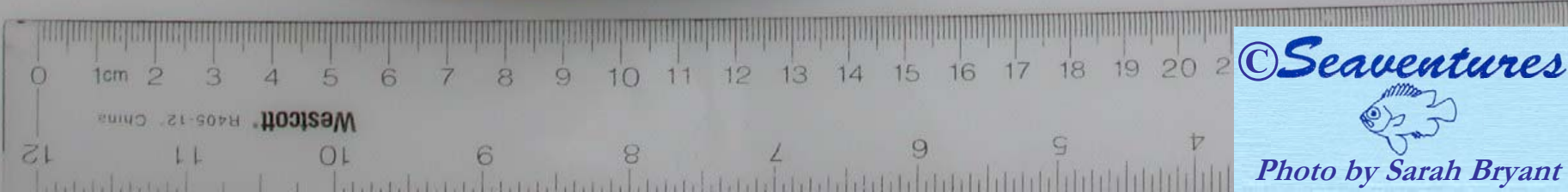

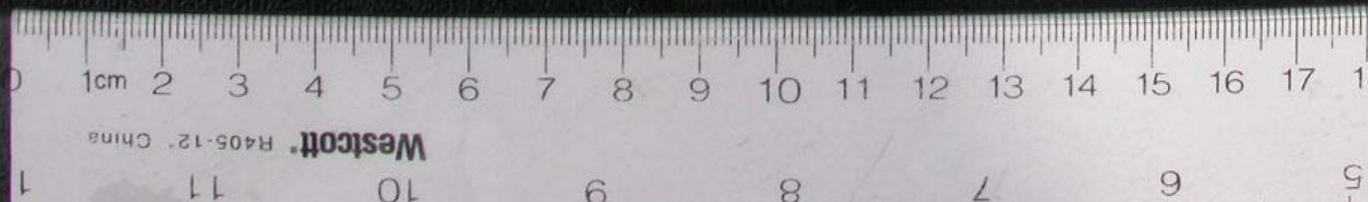
